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7 **A Resolution appropriating grant funds in the amount of \$696,076.76, in carryover**
8 **balances in various grants for 2013, for the Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.**

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10 WHEREAS, the County Prosecutor's Office ("Prosecutor") has two Domestic Violence
11 ("DV") grants with carryover balances, including \$257.03 from the Akron Community
12 Foundation in the DV Training grant, and \$271,497.38 in the DV Federal 2011-2013 grant; and

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14 WHEREAS, the Prosecutor has grant carryover balances in Federal Victims of Crime
15 award ("VOCA") in the amount of \$68,662.01, and the State Victims Assistance award
16 ("SVAA") in the amount of \$2,210.66, from the Ohio Attorney General's Office, with an end
17 date of 9/30/13; and

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19 WHEREAS, the Prosecutor has grant carryover balances in a Direct Indictment Program
20 award of \$340,877.04, funded by participating Summit County municipalities; and

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22 WHEREAS, the Prosecutor has federal grant carryovers balances in the Child Support
23 Enforcement Agency's ("CSEA") Special Improvement Project Grant from the U.S. Department
24 of Health and Human Services in the amount of \$12,572.64; and

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26 WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate these carryover balances from 2012 for 2013
27 operations; and

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29 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
30 that the appropriation of aforementioned carryover funds, in the amount of \$696,076.76, is
31 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;
