7 **A Resolution appropriating \$172,005.86 within the Neighborhood Stabilization Program**
8 **2009 grant program funding, from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban**
9 **Development, for the fiscal year ending 12/31/13, for the Executive's Department of**
10 **Community and Economic Development, and declaring an emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, the Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development
13 has an ending balance of available funds in the amount of \$172,005.86 within the Neighborhood
14 Stabilization Program ("NSP") 2009 grant program funding, from the U.S. Department of
15 Housing and Urban Development ("HUD"); and

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17 WHEREAS, this five-year NSP program was awarded \$3,767,144.00 in funds to manage
18 the program and purchase vacant, abandoned and foreclosed homes in target areas, and to
19 rehabilitate and sell the properties to income-qualified individuals; and

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21 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
22 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to appropriate the remaining
23 balance of the aforementioned grant funds, in the amount of \$172,005.86;
