7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute an intergovernmental agreement**
8 **with Summit County Children Services for the County Sheriff's Office to provide**
9 **telephone call answering services to Children Services, for the period 7/1/13 through**
10 **6/30/14, for a flat rate of \$20,000.00 per year, billed in equal monthly installments of**
11 **\$1,666.67, with three options to renew for an additional one-year term, for the Sheriff, and**
12 **declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, Summit County Children Services ("SCCS") wishes to execute an
15 intergovernmental agreement with the County for the County Sheriff's Office to provide
16 telephone call answering services to SCCS, for the period 7/1/13 through 6/30/14, for a flat rate
17 of \$20,000.00 per year, billed in equal monthly installments of \$1,666.67, with three options to
18 renew for an additional one-year term; and

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20 WHEREAS, the County wishes to provide said services through the Sheriff's Office; and

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22 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
23 that the aforementioned agreement is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
26 of Ohio, that;

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28 SECTION 1

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30 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute an intergovernmental agreement
31 with the Summit County Children Services ("SCCS") for the County Sheriff's Office to provide
32 telephone call answering services to SCCS, for the period 7/1/13 through 6/30/14, for a flat rate
33 of \$20,000.00 per year, billed in equal monthly installments of \$1,666.67, with three options to
34 renew for an additional one-year term. The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute
35 the agreement in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit A. The agreement is approved
36 with changes therein not inconsistent with this Resolution and not substantially adverse to the
37 County which shall be approved by the County Executive; provided that the approval of those
38 changes by the County Executive and the character of such changes as not being substantially
39 adverse to the County shall be evidenced conclusively by the execution of the agreement.

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41 SECTION 2

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43 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and
44 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately
45 authorizing the Sheriff's Office to provide telephone call answering services to SCCS in 2013.

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47 SECTION 3

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49 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
50 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
51 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
