7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute an Ohio Public Works**
8 **Commission grant application and associated documents, with Richfield Township as lead**
9 **applicant, for the Hawkins Road Improvement Project, in the Townships of Richfield and**
10 **Hinckley and the Village of Richfield, in Council District 1, in an amount not to exceed**
11 **\$30,000.00, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the County Engineer concludes that there is a public safety need to improve
14 Hawkins Road (which becomes Bellus Road in Hinckley Township), between Broadview Road
15 and State Road ("Project"), in the Townships of Richfield and Hinckley and the Village of
16 Richfield, in Council District 1; and

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18 WHEREAS, the County of Summit is eligible, with Richfield Township as lead
19 applicant, to acquire Ohio Public Works Commission Local Transportation Improvement
20 Program ("LTIP") grant funds and/or State Capital Improvement Program ("SCIP") grant funds
21 for the Project; and

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23 WHEREAS, Summit County has two bridges within the Project limits that are in need
24 maintenance ("RFT-185-0035 and RFV-185-0181"); and

26 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
27 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to apply for said funds, to authorize the
28 expenditure of up to \$30,000.00 in County local matching road and bridge funds for said
29 improvement and to authorize the County Executive to execute a grant application and
30 associated documents for the Project;

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32 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
33 of Ohio, that:

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35 SECTION 1

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37 The County Executive is authorized to execute an Ohio Public Works grant application
38 and other documents necessary for a grant for Ohio Public Works Commission Local
39 Transportation Improvement Program ("LTIP") and State Capital Improvement ("SCIP") funds,
40 with Richfield Township as lead applicant, for the purpose of improving Hawkins Road (which
41 becomes Bellus Road in Hinckley Township), between Broadview Road and State Road, in the
42 Townships of Richfield and Hinckley and the Village of Richfield, in Council District 1.

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44 SECTION 2

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46 The terms of said application shall allocate the cost of said improvement among the
47 following participants, with the County of Summit's proportional share ("Item A") not to exceed
48 \$30,000.00, and with the other participants' shares ("Items B, C, D, and E") covering the
49 remainder of the \$1,180,000.00 estimated project cost in amounts approximately equal to the
50 following:

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18 The expenditure of up to \$30,000.00 in County local matching road and bridge funds as
19 the County of Summit's share of the cost of the project is hereby authorized.
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21 SECTION 4

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23 The County Executive is authorized to execute said grant agreement and other documents
24 necessary to apply for the aforementioned grant funds only for the Ohio Public Works Program
25 Year 28 (2013-2014), with further authorization required for any future grant applications for the
26 Hawkins Road Improvement Project.
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28 SECTION 5

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30 The Clerk of Council is instructed to provide four certified copies of this Resolution to
31 the County Engineer, for submission to the Ohio Public Works Commission with said funding
32 application.
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34 SECTION 6

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36 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
37 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it will allow the
38 County to obtain grant funds for an immediately needed road safety improvement in Council
39 District 1.

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43 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
44 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
45 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
