7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to enter into an agreement with the City of**
8 **Akron for the joint resurfacing of South Main Street, in the City of Akron and Coventry**
9 **Township, in Council District 8, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

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11 WHEREAS, the County Engineer has determined it is in the best interest of the County
12 of Summit to resurface South Main Street, between Portage Lakes Drive (C.H. 75) and Althea
13 Avenue ("Project"); and

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15 WHEREAS, a portion of South Main Street within the project area is owned by the City
16 of Akron; and

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18 WHEREAS, the City of Akron and the County would like to enter into an agreement
19 stating the County will act as the administrator of the joint project and stating the City of Akron
20 will reimburse the County for 5.17% of the Project's local costs; and

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22 WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the cost to the City of Akron will be \$24,820.00; and

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24 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
25 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
26 enter into an agreement with the City of Akron for the joint resurfacing of South Main Street;

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28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
29 of Ohio, that;

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31 SECTION 1

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33 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with the City of
34 Akron, whereby the County Engineer will act as administrator for the joint resurfacing of South
35 Main Street, and the City of Akron is responsible for 5.17% of the Project's local costs. A copy
36 of said agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

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38 SECTION 2

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40 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
41 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately
42 allow the Executive to execute said agreement and to immediately improve South Main Street in
43 Akron.

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45 SECTION 3

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47 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
48 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
49 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
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SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
