7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to award a grant to the Village of Boston**  
8 **Heights, in the amount of \$51,978.11, from the Fiscal Year 2011 Metropolitan Medical**  
9 **Response System grant program funds, for the period ending 4/30/14, in Council District 1,**  
10 **for the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management - Division of**  
11 **Public Safety/Emergency Management Agency, and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, the Summit County Emergency Management Agency ("EMA") receives  
14 Metropolitan Medical Response System ("MMRS") funds on an annual basis to provide  
15 capabilities to better mitigate, prepare, respond and recover from an act of terrorism and other  
16 disasters within the medical and first responder communities; and

17  
18 WHEREAS, the Village of Boston Heights requested Fiscal Year ("FY") 2011 MMRS  
19 funding in the amount of \$51,978.11 to assist with the purchase of radios in order to join the  
20 Summit County/Akron 800 MHz Regional Radio System; and

22 WHEREAS, the Summit County Domestic Preparedness Steering Committee, the grant's  
23 oversight committee, has previously recommended approval of this award; and

25 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
26 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the County Executive to  
27 award the aforementioned grant to the Village of Boston Heights;

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
30 of Ohio, that:

34 The County Executive is hereby authorized to make a grant award to the Village of  
35 Boston Heights, in the amount of \$51,978.11, from the Fiscal Year ("FY") 2011 Metropolitan  
36 Medical Response System grant program funds, in Council District 1, for the period ending  
37 4/30/14.

39 SECTION 2

41 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare  
42 of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately awarding  
43 grant funds in the amount of \$51,978.11 to the Village of Boston Heights in order to make radio  
44 purchases to provide interoperability on the county-wide radio system.

48 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
49 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
50 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


