A Resolution determining to proceed with the submission to the electors of the County of Summit the question of the renewal of an existing 2.95 mills tax levy for the purpose of mental health and recovery programs for children, adults, and families for the County service district, and for the acquisition, construction, renovation, financing, maintenance and operation of the County of Summit Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services Board facilities, for the Executive, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, on <u>June 3</u>, 2013, this Council adopted Resolution No. 2013-246 (the "Resolution of Necessity") declaring the necessity of submitting to the voters of the County the question of the renewal of a 2.95 mill tax levy in excess of the ten-mill limitation for the purpose of mental health and recovery programs for children, adults, and families for the County service district, and for the acquisition, construction, renovation, financing, maintenance and operation of the County of Summit Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services ("ADM") Board facilities; and

WHEREAS, the County Fiscal Officer has certified to this Council that the total current tax valuation of the County is \$_11,417,698,200. and that the 2.95 mills per each dollar of tax valuation specified in the Resolution of Necessity will generate \$_34,117,360 of revenue per year in accordance with Section 5705.03(B) of the Ohio Revised Code, which certification is attached hereto as Exhibit A (the "Fiscal Officer Certification"); and

WHEREAS, this Council has received the report of the County of Summit Social Services Advisory Board in accordance with the Resolution of Necessity approving the request and proposal of the ADM Board for the approval of the aforesaid levy; and

WHEREAS, this Council now determines to proceed with the submission of the question of the renewal of the aforesaid levy to the voters of the County at the November 5, 2013 general election;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, two-thirds of all the members elected thereto concurring, that:

SECTION 1

The question of the renewal of an additional 2.95 mill tax levy for the purpose of mental health and recovery services for children, adults, families and the elderly for the County service district, and for the acquisition, construction, renovation, financing, maintenance and operation of the County of Summit Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services ("ADM") Board facilities, for a period of six (6) years, beginning with the 2014 tax list and duplicate, the proceeds of which levy first would be distributed in calendar year 2015, shall be submitted under provisions of Sections 5705.221 and 5705.25 of the Revised Code to the electors of the County of Summit at the general election to be held therein on November 5, 2013, as authorized by law. The election shall be held at the regular places of voting in the County as established by the
