7 **A Resolution adjusting existing appropriations by \$7,000.00 for capital improvements, for**
8 **the fiscal year ending 12/31/13, for the Executive Department of Administrative Services –**
9 **Physical Plants, and declaring an emergency.**

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11 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2013-028, which approved
12 and appropriated the 2013 capital improvements budget, for the fiscal year ending 12/31/13; and

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14 WHEREAS, adjustments to the appropriations within the capital improvements budget
15 are needed in order to provide for demolition of the Veterans Services former offices on Park
16 Street in Akron; and

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18 WHEREAS, a transfer of \$7,000.00 in the current appropriations from the Parking Deck
19 Repairs to the Veterans Service Building is required in order to provide funding for this project;

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22 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
23 that the adjustment in the appropriation of the aforementioned funds is necessary and in the best
24 interest of the County of Summit;
