7 **A Resolution appropriating funds in the amount of \$417,016.00 for the Harrington Road**
8 **Bridge Rehabilitation Project, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

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10 WHEREAS, the Tuscarawas River Diversion Dam located in the City of Akron, Ohio, is
11 controlled by the Ohio Department of Natural Resources ("ODNR"); and

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13 WHEREAS, ODNR plans to make improvements to the Tuscarawas River Diversion
14 Dam; and

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16 WHEREAS, the Harrington Road Bridge, Bridge No. AKR-227-0023, located in the City
17 of Akron ("Bridge"), is controlled and maintained by the County Engineer; and

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19 WHEREAS, the Bridge spans a portion of the Tuscarawas River Diversion Dam; and

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21 WHEREAS, due to advanced deterioration of bridge concrete-encased bearings and
22 superstructure, the Engineer determined that load limit restrictions on the bridge were necessary
23 and that cooperative agreements were needed for the rehabilitation of the Bridge; and

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25 WHEREAS, the Engineer has requested that bridge rehabilitation ("Bridge Project")
26 plans prepared by DLZ Ohio, Inc., on behalf of the Engineer, be included in the ODNR Portage
27 Lakes State Park Tuscarawas River Diversion Dam improvements ("Dam Project") plans for
28 purposes of improvement of the Bridge; and

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30 WHEREAS, the Director of the ODNR has agreed to cooperate with the Engineer by
31 including the project into the Dam Project Plans; and

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33 WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority provided by this Council in Resolution No. 2013-
34 005, the County has entered into a Cooperative Agreement with ODNR whereby ODNR agreed
35 to bid the Bridge Project as part of the Dam Project provided that the County pay 100% of the
36 costs of the Bridge Project directly to the selected contractor; and

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38 WHEREAS, ODNR subsequently bid the Dam Project, and Kenmore Construction
39 Company was low bidder with the Bridge Project portion being bid at \$417,016.00; and

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41 WHEREAS, the County also procured grant funds from the Ohio Public Works
42 Commission ("OPWC") to cover 95% of the Bridge Project costs, in the amount of \$396,165.20;
43 and

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45 WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate the grant funds from the OPWC and to also
46 appropriate funds from the Motor Vehicle Gas Tax Capital Improvement Fund in the amount of
47 \$20,850.80 for the balance of the Bridge Project costs;

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49 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
50 that the aforementioned appropriation is necessary and in the best interest of the County of
51 Summit;

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

Funds are hereby appropriated as follows:

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately appropriate said funds so that the Bridge Project may begin as soon as possible.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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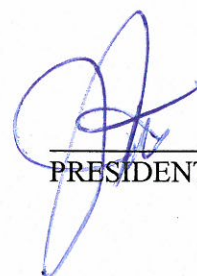

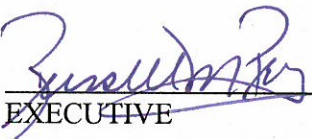
