SECTION 1

Sections 505.52, 505.56 and 505.58 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit are hereby amended in the manner set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2

This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately amending the aforementioned Sections in order to timely comply with the requirements of Chapter 955 of the Ohio Revised Code regarding the establishment of license fees by August 31, 2013.

SECTION 3

Provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

INTRODUCED
