7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**
 8 **accept an award by the Ohio Emergency Management Agency of a Fiscal Year 2012**
 9 **Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness grant, for the period 10/1/12 through**
 10 **9/30/13, in the amount of \$5,950.00, with no local cash match requirement and**
 11 **appropriating \$5,950.00 for training expenditures, for the Executive’s Department of Law,**
 12 **Insurance and Risk Management – Division of Public Safety/Emergency Management**
 13 **Agency, and declaring an emergency.**

15 WHEREAS, the Ohio Emergency Management Agency (“OEMA”) provides funding to
 16 increase capabilities to better mitigate, prepare, respond and recover from an act of terrorism and
 17 other disasters within the medical and first responder communities; and
 18

19 WHEREAS, OEMA has awarded Summit County Emergency Management Agency
 20 additional funding under the Fiscal Year (“FY”) 2012 Hazardous Materials Emergency
 21 Preparedness (“HMEP”) grant, for the period 10/1/12 through 9/30/13, in the amount of
 22 \$5,950.00, with no local cash match requirement, to provide HazMatIQ training for first
 23 responders; and

25 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
 26 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the County Executive to
 27 execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the grant from OEMA, and to
 28 appropriate these funds;

 38 9/30/13, in the amount of \$5,950.00 and to appropriate these funds.

19 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.




