A Resolution certifying deferred sewer tap-in fees to the Fiscal Officer, for the Executive's Department of Environmental Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Section 923.05(c) of Title V of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit provides for the certification of sewer tap-in fees under the extended payment program administered by the Executive's Department of Environmental Services; and

WHEREAS, Section 923.05(c) of Title V of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit provides that these charges are to be certified to the Fiscal Officer and placed on the property tax duplicate for collection; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that certifying the aforementioned charges to the Fiscal Officer is necessary and in the best interests of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

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The sewer tap-in fees of the following participants in the County's extended payment program for financially disadvantaged residents, charitable agencies and public institutions are certified to the County Fiscal Officer to be placed on the tax list and duplicated and collected as other taxes are collected in the annual installments as stated below, payable semiannually without interest, as provided by Section 923.05(c) of Title V of the Codified Ordinances and Section 6117.02(B) of the Ohio Revised Code.
