A Resolution accepting the Summit County Broadband Initiative Final Report, dated August 27, 2013, a feasibility study funded through the Local Government Innovation Fund of the State of Ohio concerning a shared broadband infrastructure within Summit County, as final and complete, for the Executive, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio established the Local Government Innovation Fund ("LGIF") to provide financial assistance to Ohio political subdivisions for planning and implementing projects that are projected to create more efficient and effective service delivery within a specific discipline of government services for one or more entities; and

WHEREAS, the County, through Resolution No. 2012-060 and numerous collaborative partners ("Collaborative Partners") in Summit County, entered into a partnership agreement to submit a grant application to LGIF to fund the costs of a feasibility study ("Feasibility Study") regarding a shared broadband infrastructure that would support future consolidations of, and collaborations concerning, government functions performed by the parties; and

WHEREAS, the County, as the lead applicant and fiscal agent, and Collaborative Partners applied to the LGIF for and were awarded \$100,000.00 in funding to perform the Feasibility Study; and

WHEREAS, under the terms of the LGIF grant agreement, the State of Ohio shall withhold 30% of grant funds from the County until the State of Ohio is notified that the Feasibility Study final deliverable report ("Final Report") has been adopted by the County as final and complete; and

WHEREAS, the Final Report was completed and submitted to the County and the Collaborative Partners as of August 27, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of this Final Report as final and complete does not bind the County or any of the Collaborative Partners to finance or implement the recommendations included in the Final Report; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to adopt the Final Report as final and complete;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:
