SECTION 1

This Council hereby expresses its support of Issue 1 to renew a 2.95 mill tax levy, for the County of Summit Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services ("ADM") Board, to appear on the ballot at the general election on November 5, 2013, for the urgently needed purpose of mental health and recovery programs for the children, adults and families for the County service district and for the acquisition, construction, renovation, financing, maintenance and operation of the ADM Board's facilities.

SECTION 2

The residents of Summit County are respectfully urged to support Issue 1 so that the ADM Board will be able to continue to provide urgently needed mental health and addiction services to adults, children and families in the County.
