7 **A Resolution adjusting appropriations in the amount of \$4,267.50 and appropriating**  
8 **additional funds in the amount of \$11,000.00 through 12/31/13 for the Youth Employment**  
9 **for Success program, for the Executive’s Department of Communications, and declaring an**  
10 **emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, this Council previously approved, pursuant to Resolution No. 2013-183, an  
13 agreement between the Executive’s Department of Job and Family Services and the Executive’s  
14 Department of Communications’ Youth Employment for Success Program (“YES”), in the  
15 amount of \$94,000.00, for the operation of a 2013 Summer Youth Program, to be paid out of  
16 federal Temporary Assistance for Needy Family (“TANF”) funds; and

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18 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2013-183, this Council previously appropriated  
19 the \$94,000.00 received by the YES program under the aforementioned contract; and

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21 WHEREAS, the Executive’s Department of Job and Family Services has approved an  
22 additional award of \$11,000.00 in TANF funds for the YES’s 2013 Summer Youth Program; and

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24 WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate these additional funds and adjust existing  
25 appropriations in the amount of \$4,267.50 for YES’s 2013 Summer Youth Program; and

27 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
28 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to appropriate the  
29 aforementioned funds in the amount of \$11,000.00 and adjust existing appropriations in the  
30 amount of \$4,267.50 for YES’s 2013 Summer Youth Program;

20 and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


