7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive and County Engineer to apply for Federal**
8 **Surface Transportation Program funds programmed by the Akron Metropolitan Area**
9 **Transportation Study, with the City of Cuyahoga Falls as lead applicant, to improve Steels**
10 **Corners Road, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

11
12 WHEREAS, the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (“AMATS”) has issued
13 a notification seeking application for projects to be constructed in 2018 and 2019; and

14
15 WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls has identified the resurfacing of Steels Corners
16 Road from State Road to Wyndham Ridge Drive (“Project”) as a project eligible for Federal
17 Surface Transportation (“STP”) funds; and

18
19 WHEREAS, the Project includes asphalt work on the County-owned Steels Corners Road
20 Bridge over Mud Brook; and

21
22 WHEREAS, the federal programs will provide up to 80% of the construction and right of
23 way costs for the Project;

24
25 WHEREAS, the total Project cost is estimated at \$375,000.00, and the County’s portion
26 of the Project is estimated to be \$3,000.00; and

28 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information
29 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County
30 Executive and County Engineer to apply for Federal STP funds for the Project;

32 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
33 of Ohio, that:

35 SECTION 1

36
37 The County Executive and the County Engineer, on behalf of the County of Summit, are
38 hereby authorized to apply for Federal Surface Transportation Program (“STP”) funds
39 programmed by the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (“AMATS”), with the City
40 of Cuyahoga Falls as the lead applicant, for the resurfacing of Steels Corners Road from State
41 Road to Wyndham Ridge Drive (“Project”), with the cost sharing as follows:

43 Surface Transportation Program funds: \$300,000.00
44 City of Cuyahoga Falls: \$ 67,000.00
45 City of Stow: \$ 5,000.00
46 County of Summit: \$ 3,000.00

4 SECTION 2

6 That the County of Summit acknowledges and understands the AMATS funding policy
7 guidelines and confirms to the best of its knowledge that the information contained in the Project
8 application is accurate, that it intends to diligently pursue that Project, and that a local share is
9 required to match federal funds.

10 SECTION 3

12 The Clerk of Council is instructed to provide two certified copies of this Resolution to the
13 Engineer for submission to AMATS as part of the funding application.

15 SECTION 4

16
17 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
18 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reasons that it will
19 immediately allow the County to obtain grants for road improvements.

21 SECTION 5

22
23 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
24 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
25 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

27 SECTION 6

29 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
30 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
31 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
32 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
33 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
