WHEREAS, County Council previously approved Resolution No. 98-719, which declared the County's intent to participate in the Downtown Akron Special Improvement District ("District") and permitted the inclusion of the County's real property located in downtown Akron as a part of the District; and		
WHEREAS, County Council previously approved Resolution No. 99-310, which approved the District's first five-year Plan of Services and authorized the Executive to execute petition approving the Plan of Services; and		
WHEREAS, County Council also previously approved Resolution No. 2004-109, which approved the District's second five-year Plan of Services and authorized the Executive execute another petition approving and extending the Plan of Services; and		
WHEREAS, County Council also previously approved Resolution No. 2008-526, which approved the District's third five-year Plan of Services and authorized the Executive to execute another petition approving and extending the Plan of Services; and		
WHEREAS, the District has developed a new five-year Plan of Services and har requested that the County approve, and that the County Executive execute, a new petition approving the Plan of Services; and		
WHEREAS, the Plan of Services will be financed with special assessments against the real property within the District, including the real property owned by the County; and		
WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to approve said Plan of Services for the District and to authorize the County Executive to execute a petition approving and extending the Plan of Services.		
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:		
SECTION 1		

The Downtown Akron Special Improvements District's Plan of Services, including the assessment of the County's real property included in the District, is hereby approved and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a petition approving and extending the Plan of Services. A copy of said petition is attached hereto as Exhibit A and a copy of the estimated assessment for the Plan of Services is attached hereto as Exhibit B, both of which are incorporated herein by reference.
