7 **An amended Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a Subrecipient**
8 **Agreement and Amendments to Subrecipient Agreements for the Moving Ohio Forward**
9 **Demolition Program with certain communities to award and increase the award of the**
10 **County's grants under said Subrecipient Agreements, for the Executive's Department of**
11 **Community and Economic Development, and declaring an emergency.**

12
13 WHEREAS, the Summit County Land Reutilization Corporation ("SCLRC") is the
14 recipient of grant funds under the Ohio Attorney General's Moving Ohio Forward program, to
15 perform residential demolitions within Summit County; and

16
17 WHEREAS, the SCLRC and the County have entered into a Subrecipient and
18 Administration Agreement whereby the SCLRC has granted said Moving Ohio Forward funds to
19 the County for administration of the funds and distribution to the municipalities and townships
20 throughout Summit County; and

21
22 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2012-310, this Council authorized the County
23 Executive to enter into Subrecipient Agreements with the municipalities and townships in
24 Summit County to be the ultimate recipient of the Moving Ohio Forward funds and to perform
25 residential demolitions within their jurisdictions; and

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27 WHEREAS, a handful of communities did not enter into the Subrecipient Agreements,
28 the County terminated some Subrecipient Agreements due to lack of expending funds, and others
29 have voluntarily terminated their Subrecipient Agreements due to a lack of need within their
30 communities, thereby resulting in funds being available for redistribution to other communities;
31 and

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33 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2013-271, this Council previously authorized an
34 amendment to the Subrecipient Agreement with the Village of Richfield to provide additional
35 funding of \$10,000.00 in Moving Ohio Forward funds and an additional \$10,000.00 contribution
36 from the Village of Richfield; and

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38 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2013-304, this Council previously authorized an
39 amendment to the Subrecipient Agreement with the City of Cuyahoga Falls to provide additional
40 funding of \$10,000.00; and

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42 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2013-378, this Council previously authorized
43 Amendments to the Subrecipient Agreements with the City of Barberton and Coventry Township
44 to provide additional funding of ~~\$34,500.00~~ \$35,000.00 and \$25,000.00, respectively; and

46 WHEREAS, the County Executive's Department of Community and Economic
47 Development has recommended that this Council authorize the County Executive to enter into a
48 Subrecipient Agreement with Bath Township, which did not previously execute a Subrecipient
49 Agreement, to provide funding in the amount of ~~\$10,000.00~~ \$15,000.00 in Moving Ohio
50 Forward funds, with an additional \$5,000.00 contribution from Bath Township; and

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4 WHEREAS, the County Executive's Department of Community and Economic
5 Development has recommended that this Council authorize the County Executive to enter into
6 Amendments to the Subrecipient Agreements with the following communities for the following
7 amounts:

9 Twinsburg Township – an additional \$40,000.00 in Moving Ohio Forward Funds
10 Springfield Township – an additional ~~\$90,000.00~~ \$25,000.00 in Moving Ohio Forward
11 Funds
12 ~~City of Barberton – an additional \$100,000.00 in Moving Ohio Forward Funds; and~~

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14 WHEREAS, the County Executive's Department of Community and Economic
15 Development has recommended that this Council authorize the County Executive to enter into an
16 Amendment to the Subrecipient Agreement with Sagamore Hills Township, which previously
17 executed a Subrecipient Agreement which was later terminated due to lack of expending funds
18 to reinstate the Subrecipient Agreement and to provide a total of \$10,000.00 in Moving Ohio
19 Forward funds; and

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21 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
22 that it is necessary and in the best interest of this Council, to authorize the Executive to enter into
23 the aforementioned Subrecipient Agreement and Amendments to Subrecipient Agreements.

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25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
26 State of Ohio, that:

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28 SECTION 1

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30 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a Subrecipient Agreement with
31 Bath Township, which did not previously execute a Subrecipient Agreement, to provide funding
32 in the amount of ~~\$10,000.00~~ \$15,000.00 in Moving Ohio Forward funds, with an additional
33 \$5,000.00 contribution from Bath Township.

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35 SECTION 2

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37 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute Amendments to the Subrecipient
38 Agreements with the following communities for the following amounts:

40 Twinsburg Township – an additional \$40,000.00 in Moving Ohio Forward Funds
41 Springfield Township – an additional ~~\$90,000.00~~ \$25,000.00 in Moving Ohio Forward

43 ~~City of Barberton – an additional \$100,000.00 in Moving Ohio Forward Funds; and~~

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46 SECTION 3

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48 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute an Amendment to the Subrecipient
49 Agreement with Sagamore Hills Township, which previously executed a Subrecipient
50 Agreement but which was later terminated due to lack of expending funds to reinstate the
51 Subrecipient Agreement and to provide a total of \$10,000.00 in Moving Ohio Forward funds.

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6 This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety
7 and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason that it is necessary
8 to immediately authorize the execution of said agreement and amendments in order to ensure that
9 the Moving Ohio Forwards funds are spent in a timely manner.

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11 SECTION 5

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13 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
14 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect
15 and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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17 SECTION 6

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19 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
20 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
21 deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in
22 meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of
23 the Ohio Revised Code.
