7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for bids for the purchase of**
8 **seven livescan fingerprint machines, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$140,000.00,**
9 **for the Executive's Department of Law Insurance and Risk Management – Division of**
10 **Public Safety, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
13 requires this Council's authorization for the County Executive to advertise for bids; and

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15 WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to advertise for bids for seven livescan
16 machines for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$140,000.00; and

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18 WHEREAS, a copy of the technical specifications are attached as Exhibit A; and

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20 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
21 that is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
22 advertise for bids for seven livescan fingerprint machines, for an estimated total cost not to
23 exceed \$140,000.00;

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25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
26 of Ohio, that;

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28 SECTION 1

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30 The County Executive is authorized to advertise for bids for seven livescan fingerprint
31 machines per attached Exhibit A, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$140,000.00.

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33 SECTION 2

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35 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare
36 of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the
37 Executive to immediately advertise for bids for seven livescan fingerprint machines, the
38 purchase of which will be through homeland security grant funding, which expires April 30,
39 2014.

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43 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
44 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
45 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

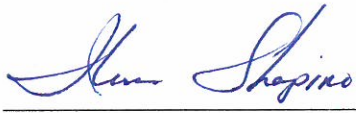
