## **SECTION 2**

This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately amend Section 177.23 of the Codified Ordinances to remove the requirement that County Council adopt an annual resolution authorizing the exemption of the types of purchases stated in Section 177.23 from certification by the County Fiscal Officer.

## **SECTION 3**

Provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

## **SECTION 4**
