7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control for a professional service**  
8 **contract with The University of Akron for instructor technician services, in an amount not**  
9 **to exceed \$26,200.00, for the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk**  
10 **Management – Division of Public Safety/Emergency Management Agency, and declaring**  
11 **an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held January 8, 2014, awarded a  
14 professional service contract with The University of Akron for instructor technician services,  
15 subject to confirmation by County Council; and

17 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
18 that the aforementioned professional service contract is necessary and in the best interest of the  
19 County of Summit;

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21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
22 of Ohio, that:

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24 SECTION 1

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26 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with The University  
27 of Akron for instructor technician services, in an amount not to exceed \$26,200.00, is hereby  
28 confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such contract.

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30 SECTION 2

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32 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
33 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose of immediately  
34 providing instructor technician services effective 1/1/14.

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36 SECTION 3

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38 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
39 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
40 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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42 SECTION 4

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44 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
45 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
46 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
47 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
48 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.  
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
