A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the Violence Against Women Act grant award from the Ohio Office of Public Safety/Office of Criminal Justice Services, for the period 1/1/14 through 12/31/14, in the amount of \$42,280.94 in federal funding, with a 25% local cash requirement of \$14,093.65, from the General Fund of the Prosecutor's General Office, for a grant total of \$56,374.59, and appropriating supplemental funds of \$226.43, for a total program appropriation of \$56,601.02, through 2014, for the Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Office of Public Safety/Office of Criminal Justice Services ("OCJS"), has awarded the Prosecutor a Violence Against Women Act ("VAWA") grant of federal funds in the amount of \$42,280.94, which requires a 25% local cash match requirement of \$14,093.65, for the period 1/1/14 through 12/31/14; and

WHEREAS, the grant award totaling \$56,374.59, reflects budget reductions by the federal budget and will require an additional funding match in the amount of \$226.43 coming from the General Fund of the Prosecutor's General Office, for a total program operating budget of \$56,601.02; and

WHEREAS, the full match funding has been provided for with appropriations within the Prosecutors 2014 operating budget identified in Resolution No. 2013-493; and

WHEREAS, this VAWA program funding supports a victim advocate position, in order to provide the mandated services to victims of crime; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the awards of the aforementioned grants from the Ohio Office of Public Safety, and to appropriate these grant funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept the Violence Against Women Act ("VAWA") grant award, from the Ohio Office of Public Safety/Office of Criminal Justice Services ("OCJS"), for the period 1/1/14 through 12/31/14, in the amount of \$56,601.02, including \$42,280.94 in grant funding, and requiring \$14,320.08 in local cash match requirements.
