7 **An Ordinance amending Chapter 741 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit,**
8 **entitled “Secondhand Dealers,” for the Executive’s Department of Law, Insurance and**
9 **Risk Management – Office of Consumer Affairs, and declaring an emergency.**

10
11 WHEREAS, the Office of Consumer Affairs already handles the licensing requirements
12 for entertainment device arcades; and

13
14 WHEREAS, Chapter 741 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit relates to
15 the regulation of secondhand dealers located within the County; and

16
17 WHEREAS, the licensing requirements for secondhand dealers are similar to the
18 licensing requirements for entertainment device arcades; and

19
20 WHEREAS, Chapter 741 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit currently
21 requires registration of secondhand dealers through the County Executive or his designee; and

22
23 WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2013-093 consolidated the Consumer Affairs Board
24 underneath the Executive’s Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management and renamed it
25 the Office of Consumer Affairs; and

26
27 WHEREAS, the County Executive has proposed that Chapter 741 be amended to
28 designate the Office of Consumer Affairs as the authority administering the restriction of
29 secondhand dealers; and

31 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
32 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to amend Chapter 741 to designate the
33 Office of Consumer Affairs as the authority administering the registration of secondhand dealers;

35 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
36 State of Ohio, that:

38 SECTION 1

40 Chapter 741 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled “Secondhand
41 Dealers,” is hereby amended as set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by
42 reference.

44 SECTION 2

46 The Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
47 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason of immediately
48 amending Chapter 741 in order to immediately provide for the orderly registration of secondhand
49 dealers in the County.

6 Provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
7 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect
8 and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

13 to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
14 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,

16 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
