WHEREAS, this has been an annual award to the Sheriff's Office in order to assist in law enforcement on the approximately 25 bodies of state water within Summit County; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grant from the ODNR, and to appropriate these grant funds;
