19 20 21 22	WHEREAS, a speed limit reduction to 35 miles per hour ("mph") along said section of Glenmount Avenue would result in a consistent 35 mph speed limit for a distance of 0.51 miles; and

34 35	SECTION 1			

Upon the basis of engineering and traffic investigations with respect to the local conditions for traffic on the unincorporated section of Glenmount Avenue (CH 149) from Swartz Road (CH 155) to Waterloo Road, in Coventry Township, in Council District 8, it is determined that the permitted speeds may be greater than is reasonable and safe under the conditions found to exist at such location, and that such speed should be reduced to a reasonable and safe prima facie speed limit as may be determined.

SECTION 2

The Director of the State of Ohio Department of Transportation is hereby requested pursuant to Section 4511.21 (I)(1) of the Ohio Revised Code to review engineering and traffic investigation reports and to determine and declare a reasonable and safe prima facie speed limit for said County highway.

SECTION 3

In the event the Director of the State of Ohio Department of Transportation determines that the reduction of the presently declared speed limit is necessary, reasonable, and safe, as requested herein, then the County Engineer is authorized to erect appropriate signs giving notice thereof, and the speed limit declared by the Director of the Ohio Department of Transportation shall become effective when such signs are erected.

SECTION 4

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it will immediately promote safety on county roadways.

SECTION 5

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 6

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
