A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase order with Serpentini Chevrolet for one 2014 Chevrolet Traverse all wheel drive sport utility vehicle, under CUE pricing, in an amount not to exceed \$27,738.11, which includes a trade-in value of \$1,200.00 for a surplus 2001 Ford Explorer, for the Medical Examiner, and declaring an emergency.
