7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase order with**  
8 **Serpentini Chevrolet for one 2014 Chevrolet Traverse all wheel drive sport utility vehicle,**  
9 **under CUE pricing, in an amount not to exceed \$27,738.11, which includes a trade-in value**  
10 **of \$1,200.00 for a surplus 2001 Ford Explorer, for the Medical Examiner, and declaring an**  
11 **emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held April 2, 2014, awarded a purchase  
14 order with Serpentini Chevrolet for one 2014 Chevrolet Traverse all wheel drive sport utility  
15 vehicle, under CUE pricing, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

17 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
18 that the purchase order is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
21 of Ohio, that:

25 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase order with Serpentini Chevrolet for one  
26 2014 Chevrolet Traverse all wheel drive sport utility vehicle, under CUE pricing, in an amount  
27 not to exceed \$27,738.11, which includes a trade-in value of \$1,200.00 for a surplus 2001 Ford  
28 Explorer, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such  
29 purchase order.

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31 SECTION 2

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33 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
34 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
35 provide for the replacement of an unreliable vehicle in the Medical Examiner's office.

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39 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
40 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
41 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

46 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
47 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,

49 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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
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


