7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase order for general**  
8 **encumbrances for deputies uniform allowances for Fiscal Year 2014, per Article 27 of the**  
9 **Deputies Bargaining Agreement and attached Exhibit A, with any vendor approved by the**  
10 **Sheriff's Office Uniform Allowance Committee, in a total amount not to exceed**  
11 **\$420,128.29, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held April 16, 2014, awarded a purchase  
14 order for general encumbrances for deputies uniform allowances for Fiscal Year 2014, per  
15 Article 27 of the Deputies Bargaining Agreement and attached Exhibit A, with any vendor  
16 approved by the Sheriff's Office Uniform Allowance Committee, subject to confirmation by  
17 County Council; and

19 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
20 that the purchase order is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
23 of Ohio, that:

25 SECTION 1

27 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase order for general encumbrances for  
28 deputies uniform allowances for Fiscal Year 2014, per Article 27 of the Deputies Bargaining  
29 Agreement and attached Exhibit A, with any vendor approved by the Sheriff's Office Uniform  
30 Allowance Committee, in a total amount not to exceed \$420,128.29, is hereby confirmed and the  
31 County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such purchase order.

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33 SECTION 2

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35 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
36 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
37 provide for general encumbrances for deputies uniform allowances in 2014.

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39 SECTION 3

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41 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
42 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
43 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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45 SECTION 4

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47 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
48 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
49 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
50 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
51 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.  
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
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


