7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute all documents necessary to accept**
8 **federal Temporary Assistance to Needy Families Summer Youth Employment Program**
9 **grant funds from the Summit County Department of Job and Family Services, in an**
10 **amount not to exceed \$91,920.00, and accept funds awarded for the Vernon L. Odom Fund**
11 **of Akron Community Foundation in the amount of \$500.00, with no local cash match**
12 **requirement, and appropriating the total of \$92,420.00 for the Youth Employment for**
13 **Success 2014 summer youth programs, for the Executive's Department of**
14 **Communications, and declaring an emergency.**

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16 WHEREAS, the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services ("DJFS") has been
17 awarded Temporary Assistance to Needy Families ("TANF") funds from the Ohio Department
18 of Job and Family Services, which have been appropriated for a Summer Youth Employment
19 Program in Resolution No. 2014-168; and

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21 WHEREAS, DJFS has awarded a total of \$91,920.00 of the TANF funds to the
22 Executive's Department of Communications YES 2014 Summer Youth Employment Program,
23 authorized by this Council by Resolution No. 2014-188; and

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25 WHEREAS, the Executive's Department of Communications has received an award in
26 the amount of \$500.00, with no local cash match requirement, from the Vernon L. Odom Fund of
27 the Akron Community Foundation Fund; and

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29 WHEREAS, this Vernon L. Odom Fund will support a money management workshop
30 through the 2014 Summer Youth Employment Program for the period 5/1/14 through 10/31/14;

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33 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
34 that authorizing the Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept and appropriate the
35 aforementioned grant funds is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;
