Transportation:


Skipco will pick up units from Summit County Sheriffs Department for a fee of \$55 per unit.

CONTRACT FOR SALE OF PROPERTY AT PUBLIC AUCTION

This agreement is entered into on the ____ day of _____, 20____, by and between SUMMIT COUNTY, OHIO, (hereafter "SUMMIT CO. ") and _Skipco Auto Auction_ (hereafter "Skipco"). In consideration of the mutual promises and undertakings of the parties, Seller and Skipco agree as follows:

- 1. Employment as auctioneer: SUMMIT CO. hereby employs Skipco to advertise, promote, and sell at public auction the property described below according to the terms contained in this agreement.
- 2. Date of auction or termination date of the agreement: This agreement will remain in effect until terminated in writing by either party.
- 3. Location of auction: Skipco Auto Auction, 700 Elm Ridge Ave, Canal Fulton, OH 44614

4. Property to be auctioned:

SUMMIT CO. will provide, in advance, a list of property to be auctioned and date the auction is to be held.

5. Liens or encumbrances:

6. Good title: SUMMIT CO. represents that it is the sole owner of the above property and has good title and right to sell said property. The property shall be sold [check one] free and clear of all liens and encumbrances; or _____ subject to the liens and encumbrances disclosed above. SUMMIT CO. assumes responsibility for delivering merchantable title to the property to the purchaser(s) and agrees to hold Skipco harmless from all claims against auctioneer pertaining to the delivery of such title.

7. Absolute auction / reserve auction: The auction shall be conducted as follows [check one as appropriate]:

An absolute auction. SUMMIT CO. represents that he/she has a bonafide intention to transfer the property regardless of the price or identity of the high bidder, in an auction of real or personal property to which all of the following apply:

- (a) The property is to be sold to the highest bidder without reserve;
- (b) The auction does not require a minimum bid;
- (c) The auction does not require competing bids of any type by SUMMIT CO. or agent of SUMMIT CO.;
- (d) SUMMIT CO. cannot withdraw the property from auction after the auction is opened and there is a public solicitation or calling of bids.

A reserve auction, which is an auction in which SUMMIT CO. or agent of SUMMIT CO. reserves the right to establish a stated minimum bid, the right to reject or accept any or all bids, or the right to withdraw the real or personal property at any time prior to the completion of the auction by the auctioneer. SUMMIT CO. has the option for a representative to be present at the time of the auction. SUMMIT CO.'s representative can accept or reject any or all bids at their discretion. In the event SUMMIT CO. is not represented at the auction they must provide, in writing, a list of all minimum bids prior to the auction. In the event the high bid is lower than the stated minimum bid, the bid will be placed "on approval". SUMMIT CO. has the option to accept or reject the lower bid no later than noon the next business day. After this time all pending bids will be declined and the auction and buyer will be relieved of any obligations related to said bid.

8. Costs and fees: SUMMIT CO. agrees to pay the following costs and fees, as applicable:

9. Unsold property: Unsold property is the responsibility of [check one]:

Skipco. The unsold property shall be returned to Seller within 15 days of the date of the auction unless otherwise stated in this contract.

11. Buyer Defaults: In the event a purchaser fails to complete the sale according to the terms and conditions of Skipco, the property will remain the responsibility of the seller. Skipco agrees to notify seller within 5 working days of any unsold property. Skipco agrees to auction said property at a future auction, of seller's choice, at no additional cost to seller. In the event Skipco agrees to extend or alter terms of sale or payment to the benefit of the buyer, or the auction, Skipco will become responsible for that sale and proceeds will be issued to seller as agreed in this contract.

12. Absentee bidding: SUMMIT CO. [check one]

Skipco's policy on absentee bidding is as follows:

Skipco reserves the right to accept absentee bids at its discretion. Skipco also offers most items for sale to live internet (simulcast) buyers. Internet bidding is offered to buyers at the discretion of Skipco, with the same terms and conditions as floor bidders.

13. Settlement: Settlement of the auction shall be made within 7 business days from the date of the auction, unless otherwise stated in this contract.

14. Licensure: Within the jurisdiction that this auction is to be held, Auctioneers are licensed by Ohio Department of Agriculture, Auctioneer Program. Auctioneers are bonded in favor of the State of Ohio, or an aggrieved person may initiate a claim against the auction recovery fund created pursuant to Ohio Law.
