A Resolution authorizing public hearings and publication of notice thereof on the Resolutions submitting to the voters at the November 4, 2014, general election the question of whether an additional County sales tax of one-quarter of one percent pursuant to Section 5739.026 of the Ohio Revised Code and an additional County use tax of one-quarter of one percent pursuant to Section 5741.023 of the Ohio Revised Code shall be levied for a continuing period of time for the uses set forth in those Resolutions, effective April 1, 2015, or at the earliest time permitted by law, for the Executive, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council has currently pending before it a Resolution submitting to the voters at the general election of November 4, 2014, the question of whether an additional tax in the amount of one-quarter of one percent shall be levied upon retail sales made in the County of Summit for a continuing period of time for the purposes set forth in those Resolutions, and to pay the expenses of administering the sales tax levy, pursuant to Section 5739.026 of the Ohio Revised Code, effective April 1, 2015, or at the earliest time permitted by law; and

WHEREAS, this Council also has currently pending before it a Resolution submitting to the voters at the general election on November 4, 2014 the question of whether an additional tax in the amount of one-quarter of one percent shall be levied upon the storage, use, or other consumption in the County of Summit of motor vehicles, watercraft and outboard motors and tangible personal property and services for a continuing period of time for the purposes set forth in those Resolutions and to pay the expenses of administering the use tax levy, pursuant to Section 5741.023 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, Sections 5739.026 and 5741.023 of the Ohio Revised Code require that prior to adoption of such Resolutions, two public hearings thereon shall be conducted and two notices of such hearings shall be published; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to publish notice of and conduct the aforementioned two public hearings on the sales and use tax Resolutions currently pending before this Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

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52 53 This Council shall hold two public hearings on the question of the adoption of Resolutions submitting to the voters at the November 4, 2014, general election the question of levying an additional sales tax pursuant to Section 5739.026 of the Ohio Revised Code and an additional use tax pursuant to Section 5741.023 of the Ohio Revised Code. The first public hearing is to be held at 4:30 p.m. local time on June 2, 2014, at Council Chambers, Seventh Floor, Ohio Building, 175 South Main Street, Akron, Ohio. The second public hearing is to be held at 7:00 p.m. local time on June 9, 2014, at Council Chambers, Seventh Floor, Ohio Building, 175 South Main Street, Akron, Ohio. At the hearings, all interested persons will be

heard with respect to the aforesaid Resolutions in accordance with the Rules of the Council of the County of Summit.

SECTION 2

SECTION 1 (cont'd.)

The Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to cause notice of such hearings to be published in a newspaper of general circulation in Summit County once a week for two consecutive weeks, on the same day of the week, the second publication to be not less than ten nor more than thirty days prior to the first hearing.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it is necessary in order to timely hold two public hearings required by the Ohio Revised Code on the Resolutions currently pending before this Council proposing to submit to the voters at the November 4, 2014, general election the question of whether a proposed additional sales and use tax of one-quarter of one percent should be levied.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
