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## SECTION 1

County Council hereby finds and determines that the aforementioned Shaw Road Bridge over Yellow Creek collapse (BAT-199-0068) located in Bath Township constitutes an emergency pursuant to Section 177.07(a)(3) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit.

# **SECTION 2**

As a result of the emergency circumstances, this Council hereby authorizes the County Executive to enter into contracts with contractors for the replacement of the Shaw Road Bridge over Yellow Creek which are necessary as a result of the aforementioned structural damage, without complying with the competitive bidding procedures outlined in Chapter 177 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit provided, however, that the contract shall be approved by the Board of Control, and the County Engineer, and where time permits, three quotes shall be obtained for any work to be performed prior to entering into a contract for work.

## **SECTION 3**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to allow for the immediate replacement of the Shaw Road Bridge over Yellow Creek.

## **SECTION 4**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

## **SECTION 5**

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
