WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information that the aforementioned purchase contract with Montrose Ford, Inc., is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## **SECTION 1**

The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Montrose Ford, Inc. for one 2017 Ford 4WD unmarked Explorer, one 2017 Chevrolet unmarked Impala, one 2017 Chevrolet AWD unmarked Equinox, one 2017 Chevrolet AWD unmarked Traverse, under CUE pricing, in a total amount not to exceed \$104,120. is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such purchase contract.

## **SECTION 2**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately replace unreliable vehicles for the Sheriff's Drug Unit Task Force in 2016.

## **SECTION 3**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

## **SECTION 4**
