A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Opportunity Parish Ecumenical Ministry to provide case management services for Bridges out of Poverty class graduates from the Ministry's class sites, for a one-year term, from 10/1/16 through 9/30/17, in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Bridges out of Poverty ("BOP") is a model used to assist low income BOP class participants in creating and implementing plans for transitioning out of poverty, while utilizing case management and mentoring services; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held August 17, 2016, awarded a professional service contract with Opportunity Parish Ecumenical Ministry to provide case management services for Bridges out of Poverty class graduates from the Ministry's class sites, for a one-year term, from 10/1/16 through 9/30/17, in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information that the aforementioned professional service contract with Opportunity Ecumenical Ministry is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Opportunity Parish Ecumenical Ministry to provide case management services for Bridges Out of Poverty class graduates from the Ministry's class sites, for a one-year term, from 10/1/16 through 9/30/17, in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized such professional service contract.

## **SECTION 2**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to provide for case management services for Bridges out of Poverty graduates of the Ministry effective 10/1/16.

## **SECTION 3**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
