## SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of an intergovernmental agreement with the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division, for Jobs Reentry services, for a one-year term, from 10/1/16 through 9/30/17, in an amount not to exceed \$115,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized such intergovernmental agreement.
