A Resolution appropriating funds in the amount of \$17,548,625.54 in the General Bond Retirement Fund and the ASTRO P25 Radio System Fund for the Executive's Department of Finance and Budget, and declaring an emergency.
WHEREAS, County Council Resolution No. 2016-309 provides for the issuance and sale of bonds in the aggregate maximum principal amount of \$1,200,000, for the purpose of paying the costs of the acquisition, construction, and installation of elevator and fire alarm system improvements for the County Safety Building, including necessary appurtenances thereto; and
WHEREAS, Council Resolution No. 2016-310 provides for the issuance and sale of bonds in the aggregate maximum principal amount of \$1,700,000, for the purpose of paying the costs of the acquisition of real property located at 492 and 500 Grant Street, Akron, Ohio and the renovation, furnishing and equipping of the building thereon for the Summit County Board of Elections Early Voting Center, including necessary appurtenances thereto, and acquiring additional equipment for election operations; and
WHEREAS, Council Resolution No. 2016-311 provides for the issuance and sale of bonds in the aggregate maximum principal amount of \$19,000,000, for the purpose of paying the costs of the acquisition, construction, equipment and installation of Motorola ASTRO 25 radio communication equipment, components and radios that are necessary to upgrade the County and City of Akron's 800 MHz Regional Radio System into an APCO P25-compliant radio system, including necessary appurtenances thereto; and
WHEREAS, Council Resolution No. 2016-312 provides for the issuance and sale of bonds in the aggregate maximum principal amount of \$13,200,000, for the purpose of refunding certain maturities of general obligation bonds issued in 2004; and
WHEREAS, as a result of the aforementioned Resolutions, it is necessary to appropriate funds in the total amount of \$178,500.00 in the General Bond Retirement Fund for related issuance costs; and
WHEREAS, as a result of the aforementioned Resolutions, it is necessary to appropriate funds in the total amount of \$10,875,248.25 in the ASTRO P25 Radio System Fund for the County to exercise its right to purchase the equipment financed under its Equipment Lease Purchase Agreement with Motorola Solutions, Inc. on October 1, 2016; and
WHEREAS, as a result of the aforementioned Resolutions, it is necessary to appropriate funds in the total amount of \$6,494,877.29 in the ASTRO P25 Radio System Fund for ongoing installation programming and civil work related to the project; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:
