A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept grants from the U.S. Department of Energy and the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services for the Home Weatherization Assistance Program for the program year from 7/1/16 through 6/30/17, in a total amount of \$943,318.00, with no local cash match requirement, and appropriating funds, for the Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development has been awarded federal funds in a Home Weatherization Assistance Program ("HWAP") for program year 2016, from the U.S. Department of Energy ("DOE") in the amount of \$321,090.00, and from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services ("HHS") in the amount of \$622,228.00, for a total of \$943,318.00, with no local cash match requirement; and

WHEREAS, appropriations are required for HWAP expenditures within the guidelines of the DOE and HHS programs; and

WHEREAS, the HWAP funds annually help to provide necessary home improvements to low income citizens of the County of Summit; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the awards of the aforementioned program year 2016 HWAP funds from the DOE and HHS and to appropriate these grant funds;

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept program year 2016 Home Weatherization Assistance Program ("HWAP") awards of federal funds, from the U.S. Department of Energy ("DOE"), in the amount of \$321,090.00, and from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services ("HSS"), in the amount of \$622,228.00 for the program year 7/1/16 through 6/30/17, and appropriating the total of \$943,318.00 for expenditures in 2016, with no local cash match requirement.
