A Resolution approving the assumption by NFP Corporate Services (OH), Inc. of a professional service contract with Employee Benefits International, Inc. for general consulting services for health and wellness benefits, benefit regionalization initiatives and ad hoc services and authorizing the County Executive to execute any necessary documents to approve said assumption or to approve the assignment of the contract, for the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2015-246, which authorized the County Executive to execute a professional service contract with Employee Benefits International, Inc., subject to the approval of the Board of Control, for general consulting services for health and wellness benefits and benefit regionalization initiatives, for a one-year term, from 7/1/15 to 6/30/16, with two options to renew for an additional one-year term, for a total amount not to exceed \$140,395.00; and

WHEREAS, Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2016-220, which confirmed the award of a renewal (first of two) of said professional service contract with Employee Benefits International, Inc. for a one-year term, from 7/1/16 to 6/30/17, for a total amount not to exceed \$215,395.00; and

WHEREAS, NFP Corporate Services (OH), Inc. has acquired Employee Benefits International, Inc. and has assumed the aforementioned professional service contract; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for this Council to approve the assumption by NFP Corporate Services (OH), Inc. of the professional service contract between the County and Employee Benefits International, Inc. and to authorize the County Executive to execute any necessary documents to approve said assumption or to approve the assignment of the contract to NFP Corporate Services (OH), Inc.; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to approve the assumption by NFP Corporate Services (OH), Inc. of the professional service contract between the County and Employee Benefits International, Inc. and to authorize the County Executive to execute any necessary documents to approve said assumption or to approve the assignment of the contract to NFP Corporate Services (OH), Inc.;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

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The assumption by NFP Corporate Services (OH), Inc. of a professional service contract with Employee Benefits International, Inc. for general consulting services for health and wellness benefits, benefit regionalization initiatives and ad hoc services is hereby approved. The approval of the assumption by NFP Corporate Services (OH), Inc. of the professional

service contract with Employee Benefits International, Inc. shall apply to a renewal (first of two) of said professional service contract with Employee Benefits International, Inc. for a one-year term, from 7/1/16 to 6/30/17, for a total amount not to exceed \$215,395.00 and to any subsequent renewal of said contract. The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any necessary documents to approve the assumption by NFP Corporate Services (OH), Inc. of the professional service contract with Employee Benefits International, Inc. or to approve the assignment of said contract to NFP Corporate Services (OH), Inc.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it will immediately approve the assumption by NFP Corporate Services (OH), Inc. of a professional service contract with Employee Benefits International, Inc. and to authorize the Executive to execute any necessary documents to approve the assumption or to approve the assignment of said contract to NFP Corporate Services (OH), Inc.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
