7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a professional service**
8 **contract with Family and Community Services, Inc. for supportive services and temporary**
9 **financial assistance to U.S. military veteran families who are homeless or at risk for**
10 **becoming homeless, for a one-year term, from 9/1/16 through 9/30/17, in an amount not to**
11 **exceed \$171,226.03, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and**
12 **declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held September 7, 2016, awarded a
15 professional service contract with Family and Community Services, Inc. for supportive services
16 to U.S. military families who are homeless or at risk for becoming homeless, for a one-year term,
17 from 9/1/16 through 9/30/17, in an amount not to exceed \$171,226.03, subject to confirmation by
18 County Council; and

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20 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information,
21 that the aforementioned professional service contract with Family and Community Services, Inc.
22 is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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24 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
25 of Ohio, that:

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27 SECTION 1

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29 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Family and
30 Community Services, Inc. for supportive services and temporary financial assistance to U.S.
31 military veteran families who are homeless or at risk for becoming homeless, for a one-year
32 term, from 9/1/16 through 9/30/17, in an amount not to exceed \$171,226.03, is hereby confirmed
33 and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such professional service contract.

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35 SECTION 2

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37 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
38 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
39 provide supportive services and temporary financial assistance to U.S. military veteran families
40 who are homeless or at risk for becoming homeless effective 9/1/16.

45 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
