A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a professional service contract with Medical Mutual Services, L.L.C., subject to the approval of the Board of Control, to provide stop-loss reinsurance to County employees, for a one-year term, from 1/1/17 through 12/31/17, for an estimated total amount not to exceed \$350,000.00, and authorizing said benefits to also be provided to employees of political subdivisions that have executed a Political Subdivision Participation Agreement with the County, for the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, on behalf of the County of Summit, the County's consultant, NFP Corporate Services (OH), Inc., prepared and sent a request for proposals to vendors to provide various insurance services, including stop-loss reinsurance, to County employees; and

WHEREAS, NFP Corporate Services (OH), Inc. recommends that the County enter into a professional service contract with Medical Mutual Services, L.L.C. to provide stop-loss reinsurance to County employees, for a one-year term, from 1/1/17 through 12/31/17, in an amount not to exceed \$10.04 per employee per month, for a total amount not to exceed \$350,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the approval of the Board of Control will be required for said professional service contract with Medical Mutual Services, L.L.C.; and

WHEREAS, it is further necessary for this Council to authorize that the benefits provided to County employees pursuant to the aforementioned professional service contract with Medical Mutual Services, L.L.C. shall also be provided to employees of political subdivisions that have executed a Political Subdivision Participation Agreement with the County; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute the aforementioned professional service contract with Medical Mutual Services, L.L.C., subject to the approval of the Board of Control, to provide stop-loss reinsurance to County employees and to authorize said benefits to also be provided to employees of political subdivisions that have executed a Political Subdivision Participation Agreement with the County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a professional service contract with Medical Mutual Services, L.L.C., subject to the approval of the Board of Control, to provide stop-loss reinsurance to County employees, for a one-year term, from 1/1/17 through 12/31/17, in an amount not to exceed \$10.04 per employee per month, for an estimated total amount not to exceed \$350,000.00.

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SECTION 2

This Council hereby authorizes benefits provided to County employees pursuant to the aforementioned professional service contract with Medical Mutual Services, L.L.C. to also be provided to employees of political subdivisions that have executed a Political Subdivision Participation Agreement with the County.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately authorize the Executive to execute a necessary professional service contract with Medical Mutual Services, L.L.C. to provide stop-loss reinsurance to County employees and to immediately authorize said benefits to also be provided to employees of political subdivisions that have executed a Political Subdivision Participation Agreement with the County effective 1/1/17.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action. were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
