WHEREAS, on July 21, 2016, the Planning Commission approved the plat for the subdivision titled "The Preserve at Miller's Farm Subdivision Phase 3," concerning a subdivision in Copley Township, in Council District 5; and

WHEREAS, under Section 1103.07 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit and Section 711.041 of the Ohio Revised Code, the approval and acceptance of this Council is a prerequisite for the recording of the Subdivision plat; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the acceptance and approval of the aforementioned plat is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that;

SECTION 1

The subdivision, which shall be known as "The Preserve at Miller's Farm Subdivision Phase 3", in Copley Township, in Council District 5, together with restrictions, covenants and easements thereon, is hereby approved and accepted by the County of Summit, to be recorded by the County Fiscal Officer.

SECTION 2

The following performance bond furnished by <u>Argonaut Insurance Company</u> in the amount of <u>\$ 805,219.00</u>, having been submitted and approved, was accepted in conjunction with "The Preserve at Miller's Farm Subdivision Phase 3." The documents are to be retained by the County Executive, who is authorized to release said bond, in part or in full, upon satisfactory completion of the obligations set forth.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately facilitates development in Copley Township, in Council District 5.
