A Resolution revising the assessments for the parcels of The Preserve at Miller's Farm Subdivision Phase 1, in Copley Township, for drainage maintenance, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.
WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2014-530, which approved and accepted The Preserve at Miller's Farm Subdivision Phase 1; and
WHEREAS, by the adoption of Resolution No. 2016-369, this Council will be approving and accepting the plat for a subdivision entitled The Preserve at Miller's Farm Subdivision Phase 3; and
WHEREAS, said plat includes a drainage maintenance assessment provision signed by all owners of parcels located within said subdivision, with said provision applying to subsequent owners of the same parcels; and
WHEREAS, assessments for drainage maintenance also are permitted by Sections 6137.02 and 6137.03 of the Ohio Revised Code; and
WHEREAS, the County Engineer seeks to revise the assessments for drainage maintenance for said subdivision and to fully execute its powers and duties thereof; and
WHEREAS, the Engineer has prepared a revised special assessment worksheet, attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A, which apportions necessary charges for drainage maintenance among the subdivision's benefited parcel owners; and
WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that revising the assessments for the residents of The Preserve at Miller's Farm Subdivision Phase 1, in Copley Township, in Council District 5, for drainage maintenance, as set forth in Exhibit A attached to this Resolution, is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that;
SECTION 1
A drainage maintenance fund for The Preserve at Miller's Farm Subdivision Phase 1, in Copley Township, in Council District 5, is hereby revised.
SECTION 2
Owners of parcels within The Preserve at Miller's Farm Subdivision Phase 1 subdivision

shall be assessed for drainage maintenance, per the revised special assessment worksheet attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A. Each assessment is proportional to the estimated

benefit to the respective parcel.

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SECTION 3

SECTION 4

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately fund necessary drainage maintenance in The Preserve at Miller's Farm Subdivision Phase 1 subdivision in Copley Township.

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
