A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept two Fiscal Year 2016 State Homeland Security Grant Program awards from the Ohio Emergency Management Agency for the period 9/1/16 through 3/31/19, in a total amount of \$815,826.00, with no local cash match requirement, and appropriating said grant funds, for the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management - Division of Public Safety/Emergency Management Agency, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Emergency Management Agency ("OEMA") has awarded two Fiscal Year 2016 ("FY2016") State Homeland Security Program ("SHSP") grants to the Executive's Division of Public Safety/Emergency Management Agency, in a total amount of \$815,826.00, with no local cash match requirement, and

WHEREAS, a FY2016 SHSP grant, in the amount of \$500,000.00, is for sustainment costs supporting regional team response activities and interoperable communications; and

WHEREAS, a FY2016 SHSP-Law Enforcement grant, in the amount of \$315,826.00, is to support law enforcement capabilities throughout Homeland Security Region 5, consisting of thirteen Ohio counties; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the awards of the aforementioned grants from the OEMA and to appropriate said grant funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept a Fiscal Year 2016 ("FY2016") State Homeland Security Program ("SHSP") grant from the Ohio Emergency Management Agency ("OEMA") for sustainment costs supporting regional team response activities and interoperable communications for the period 9/1/16 through 3/31/19, in the amount of \$500,000.00, with no local cash match requirement, and a FY2016 SHSP-Law Enforcement grant from OEMA to support law enforcement capabilities throughout Homeland Security Region 5, consisting of thirteen Ohio counties, for the period 9/1/16 through 3/31/19, in the amount of \$315,826.00, with no local cash match requirement, for a total amount of \$815,826.00, with no local cash match requirement.
