A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept an award from the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services of a State Fiscal Year 2017 Comprehensive Case Management Employment Program grant of Temporary Assistance for Needy Families funds, for the period 7/1/16 through 6/30/17, in the amount of \$3,660,875.00, with no local cash match requirement, and appropriating the amount of \$900,000.00 for the period of 7/1/16 through 12/31/16, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County Executive's Department of Job and Family Services ("SCJFS") has received an award of federal funds from the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services ("ODJFS") for a State Fiscal Year 2017 Comprehensive Case Management Employment Program grant of Temporary Assistance for Needy Families ("TANF") funds, in the amount of \$3,660,875.00, with no local cash match requirement; and

WHEREAS, this TANF funding will support employment training and other supportive services to TANF-eligible participants ages 16-24 based upon a comprehensive assessment of individual participants' employment and training needs; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned State Fiscal Year 2017 Comprehensive Case Management Employment Program grant of TANF funds, in the amount of \$3,660,875.00, with no local cash match requirement, and appropriating the amount of \$900,000.00 for the period of 7/1/16 through 12/31/16;
