The County Executive is authorized to advertise for bids for one twenty bed mobile hospital with one trailer for equipment storage and transport to help provide alternate care sites during a chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear, or explosive terrorist incident or pandemic, in an amount not to exceed \$210,339.31.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the Executive to immediately advertise for bids for one twenty bed mobile hospital with one trailer for equipment storage and transport.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
