A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a real estate purchase contract with Norman Friedman for certain real estate identified as parcel no. 5618925, located on Hampshire Rd., in the City of Stow, for a total amount not to exceed \$69,900.00, for the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held December 7, 2016, awarded a real estate purchase contract with Norma Friedman for certain real estate, located on Hampshire Rd., parcel number 5618925, in the City of Stow, in Council District 3, in an amount not to exceed \$69,900.00, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

WHEREAS, this parcel is necessary to facilitate the completion of Q-452, which would relocate Pump Station 19 and redirect flow to the DSSS treatment plant No. 25 in the City of Stow; and

WHEREAS, County Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information that the renewal of the aforementioned construction contract is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a real estate purchase contract with Norman Friedman for certain real estate identified as parcel no. 5618925, located on Hampshire Rd., in the City of Stow, in Council District 3, for a total amount not to exceed \$69,900.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such a real estate contract.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and to immediately provide the purchase contract with Norman Friedman for certain real restate necessary for the relocation of Pump Station 19 located in the City of Stow.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
