WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Amended Resolution No. 2016-032, which authorized the County Executive to apply for, and accept, funds from the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency through the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund for the repair and replacement of home sewage treatment systems, in the amount of \$300,000.00, with an estimated \$20,000.00 client provided local cash match requirement, authorizing the Executive to execute a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund Assistance Agreement with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency for said purposes, and appropriating funds; and

WHEREAS, the client provided local cash match requirement is now estimated to be \$60,000.00, a \$40,000.00 increase over the original estimate; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate the additional \$40,000.00; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the appropriation of the aforementioned funds, in the amount of \$40,000.00, is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;
