An Amended Resolution, pursuant to Section 169.04(i) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Temporary Hiring Freeze," to authorize the County Sheriff to hire a up to 10 new Full Time Communication Technician I's, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Ordinance No. 2020-095, which enacted Section 169.04(i) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled, "Temporary Hiring Freeze," due to the anticipated economic crisis and related budgetary concerns resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic and the State of Ohio's Stay at Home Order; and

WHEREAS, Section 169.04(i) provides that if a County office is able to demonstrate that the filling of an existing position by hiring an employee is necessary for the effective and continued operation of the office, Council may adopt a Resolution authorizing the office to hire said employee; and

WHEREAS, a current Full Time Communication Technician I for the County's dispatch center has left County employment and a position is vacant; and

WHEREAS, funding for the position of Communication Technician I will come entirely from Coronavirus Relief Funds for the remainder of 2020; and

WHEREAS, because of the critical functions of this position, the Sheriff's Office needs to be able to hire and train a <u>up to 10</u> replacement<u>s</u>;

WHEREAS, in order for the County's dispatch center to function properly, it is necessary for the County Sheriff to fill provide for the duties of the position; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined, by reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Sheriff to hire a <u>up to 10</u> new Full Time Communication Technician I's;
