A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute an agreement for the acquisition of a slope easement and a temporary easement as part of the West Bath Road Landslide Repair Project, located in Bath Township, Council District 4, in a total amount not to exceed \$6,021.16, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, there is a public need to stabilize the landslide affecting approximately 500 feet of West Bath Road near the North Revere Road intersection, and the County intends to undertake the West Bath Road Landslide Repair Project, located in Bath Township, Council District 4 (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, certain land must be acquired by the County to be utilized as public right-of-way as part of the Project; and

WHEREAS, acquisition of lands for public rights-of-way for the Project is considered a local cost, which must be borne in whole by the local public agency performing the Project, in this case being the County of Summit; and

WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution 2020-058, which authorized the filing of an appropriations case in the Summit County Probate Court as to the property owned by Anthony J. and Amanda C. Caruso and known as 3047 W. Bath Rd., Akron, Ohio 44333; and

WHEREAS, said appropriations case was filed as Case 2020-CV-00041, but the Carusos subsequently requested to settle the case out-of-court upon the terms originally offered by the County and have executed the easements required by the County; and

WHEREAS, the County has dismissed the Case No, 2020-CV-00041 and has initiated the refund of the money deposited with the Court, in the amount of \$6,021.16; and

WHEREAS, the amount of \$6,021.16 is now due to Anthony J. and Amanda C. Caruso for said easements; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute an agreement for the acquisition of a slope easement and a temporary easement from the Carusos;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that;

## SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute an agreement for the acquisition of a slope easement and a temporary easement with the owners, Anthony J. and Amanda C. Caruso, of 3047 W. Bath Rd., Akron, Ohio 44333, in Bath Township, Council District 4, in a total amount not to exceed \$6,021.16, as part of the West Bath Road Landslide Repair Project, and to pay said amount to said owners for the easements.
