WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on May 27, 2020, awarded a purchase contract with Municipal Emergency Services, Inc. dba Warren Fire Equipment for the purchase of new Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus equipment, in an amount not to exceed \$52,464.07, subject to confirmation by County Council; and
